BHARUCH & ANKLESHWAR

From Ancient Harbour to Industrial Corridor

Situated along the lower reaches of the Narmada, Bharuch is among India's oldest continuously inhabited cities. Known in ancient sources as Bhrigukachchha and mapped by classical writers as Barygaza, it once stood as a major port linking the Indian subcontinent with wider Indian Ocean trade networks.

The construction of the Golden Bridge in 1881 connected Bharuch with Ankleshwar-symbolising continuity between a historic crossing and an emerging industrial region.

In recent decades, Ankleshwar and the surrounding belts of Panoli, Jhagadia, and Dahej have evolved into one of India's major chemical and pharmaceutical manufacturing corridors, sustaining a large and diverse industrial workforce.

This layered setting-ancient city, iconic bridge, and high-hazard industrial cluster-creates a distinctive context for occupational health. Here, industrial growth and worker wellbeing must advance together through vigilance, innovation, and ethical leadership.

By convening in Bharuch-Ankleshwar, GUJCON 2026 situates its deliberations within a living industrial landscape where occupational health is both a responsibility and a strategic necessity.

Why this theme-now

Workplace protection cannot rest on generic programmes or checklist compliance alone. The next phase of India's industrial growth demands an integrated view of safety, health, and working conditions—implemented consistently where work actually happens.

Conference approach

GUJCON 2026 translates this transition into practice through two implementation pillars:

Precision Prevention

- Clear identification of who is at risk, from what, and under which conditions

- Better use of workplace observation, exposure understanding, and measurement
- Interventions that fit work-as-done, not one-size-fits-all checklists
- Targeted, ethical practices that prioritise meaningful protection

High-Reliability Occupational Health

- Leadership engagement that treats worker health as an operational priority
- Attention to weak signals and early warnings-before harm occurs
- Systems designed to remain safe when conditions change or errors occur
- Occupational health embedded into planning, supervision, and continuous improvement

GUJCON 2026 aims to move beyond compliance minimums towards prevention that is precise, systems that are reliable, and governance that is ethically grounded.

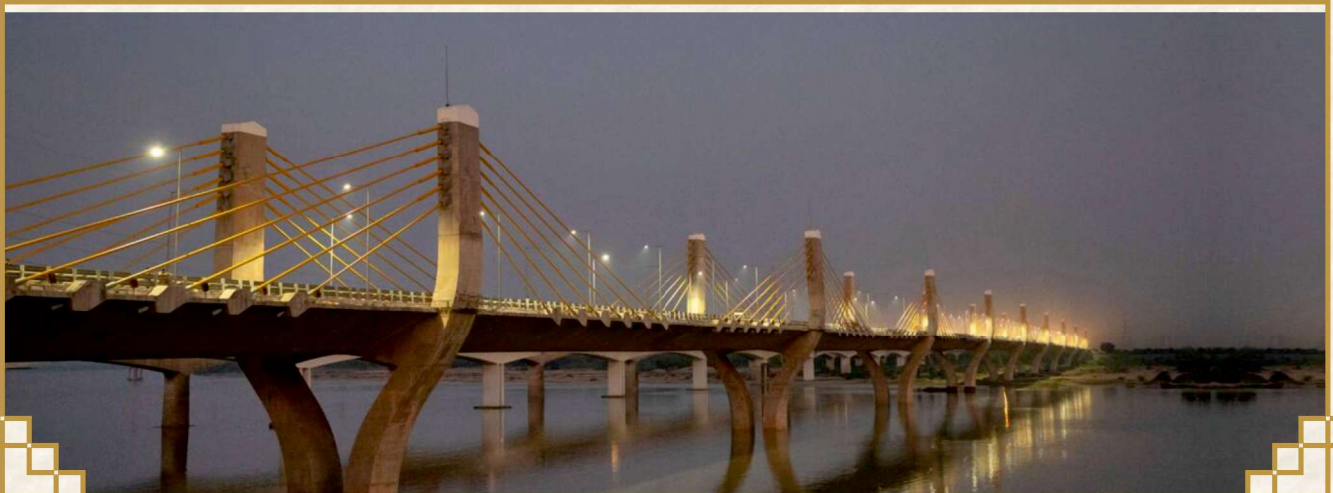
